The Pasig River Rehabilitation Commission (PRRC) was created to ensure that the Pasig River is rehabilitated to its historically pristine condition conducive for the propagation of fishes and other aquatic resources, transport, recreation and tourism. PRRC shall serve as the authority over all matters pertaining to the rehabilitation of the Pasig River. To achieve this mandate, it shall coordinate, plan, approve, implement, supervise, monitor and or evaluate plans, programs, projects and activities, enforce laws, rules and regulation where appropriate and perform such other functions are necessary to ensure the rehabilitation of the

waterway.
