FY 2020 PBB Status

The Intellectual Property Office shall Examine applications for grant of letters of patent for inventions and register utility models and industrial design.
Examines applications for the registration of marks (including internet domain names as marks), geographical indications, and integrated circuits. Registers technology transfer arrangements, settles disputes involving technology transfer payments, and develops and implements strategies to promote and facilitate technology transfer.
Promotes the use of patent information as a tool for technology development. Publishes regularly the patents, marks, utility models, and industrial designs issued and approved, and the technology transfer arrangements registered. Coordinates with other government agencies and the private sector to strengthen the protection and enforcement of intellectual property rights in the country. Administratively adjudicates cases affecting intellectual property rights
